The Ramahi Family

Following the passing of his spouse due to cancer, Mr. Ramahi decided to relocate from New Mexico to Missouri. Eventually, he returned to Sarasota, where he had family, with the hope that their support would help him start fresh for himself and his children. Initially staying with his mother in Sarasota, they faced the threat of eviction.

In dire straits, Mr. Ramahi sought refuge with Suncoast Partnership and secured emergency shelter through Harvest House. During his stay at Harvest House, he successfully found a residence through the Sarasota Housing Authority. Mr. Ramahi's case manager at Harvest House referred him to Family Promise, who played a crucial role in assisting him and his children in transitioning to their new home, facilitating the path towards stability once more.


Who is Stacy Graison?
